Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, demonstrate financial need, and show evidence of voluntary community service. Northern Arizona University (STAR) Program

The STAR program helps NAU freshmen transition into college. You must be Pell Grant eligible or a First Generation college student. In just over four weeks during the summer prior to the fall semester, you will take two classes that will fulfill liberal studies requirements and apply toward your undergraduate degree. National Security Agency: Stokes Educational Scholarship Program

The U.S. National Security Agency (NSA) is offering a career/scholarship program for eligible seniors. Applicants must be US citizens, eligible for security clearance, have an SAT score of a 1600 or ACT of a 25, plan on majoring in computer science or computer/electrical engineering, and have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Winners will receive **full tuition & books** costs paid at the

*"Not your average Joe Scholarship" Joseph Hardwick Memorial

Award will be given to High School students with a minimum 2.8 GPA. Must have good character, leadership in the community, plans to attend college, or enter the field of Aviation. Bring packet to Miss Barbie **before April 6, 2022.**

PB&J Scholarship (new this year)

neighbor, coach, church advisor.
Transcript - I can print one for you. The office can print them also. We can send them to you electronically if you would prefer to print them yourself.
