Scholarship Application

Scholarships are intended for Proclaim members who do not have a full-time call (seminarians, retired, awaiting call, on leave from call, part-time, etc). If you do have a full-time call but are experiencing financial hardship we will also consider your application. Note: Significant others of Proclaimers are not eligible for scholarships. Scholarships are given on a first come, first served basis. Scholarship applicants will be notified of their award within 14 days of their application being received. The deadline for all scholarship requests is July 5th.

Funds are limited: We do ask that applicants seek out other resources for covering gathering costs. Scholarship monies will apply only to registration fees. Scholarships will not cover travel or personal expenses. General registration includes two rooming options: single rooms are \$510, doubles are \$410. We ask that you seek out other resources for covering the additional fee if you would like a single room. If you are unable to find other funding <u>and</u> require a private room, please reach out to the Program Director **before** filling out this application.
