

Hempsall Farm Glamping Privacy Policy

We respect your right to privacy, and have put in place security measures for your personal data, along with ensuring that your personal data is managed in accordance with applicable data privacy regulations.

Please note that Hempsall Farm Glamping is the Data Controller of your personal data. The principles set out in this Privacy Notice apply to all instances in which Hempsall Farm Glamping receives your personal data as a Data Controller for the purposes described in this notice. Those purposes are processing of data in order to participate in the various activities available on this website or as mentioned below.

This privacy policy explains what information we collect through the website, when we collect it, how we use it, how it is secured, and your rights in relation to your personal data.

1. What Information We Collect

The personal data that we collect through this website is only collected once we have your consent to do so, or if it is needed to provide (and improve) our service to you.

Where personal data is collected on the website, we will give details on why your personal information is needed and how it will be used, unless it's obvious.

1.a) Information you provide us with

When using the site, you may provide personal data that we collect. Examples of personal data include name, email address, postcode, and billing information. You may provide us with Personal Data in various ways on our website, for example, when you book one of our tents or fill out the form on our [/contact-us/](#) page.

1.b) Automatically collected information

When a user visits our website, we automatically collect information from the user's device, using various technology such as cookies. Examples of automatically collected information includes: IP address, web browser, device type, and the web pages/websites visited before using the site. We may also use technology to collect information regarding a user's interaction with email messages that we send out, such as open & click data.

1.c) Information from other sources

We may collect information, including personal data, from third parties and sources, such as our partners, advertisers, and integrated services. If we associate or combine information from other sources with Personal Data that we collect through this website, we will treat this information as Personal Data in accordance with this policy.

2. Children's privacy protection

Our services are not designed for, or intentionally targeted at, children 13 years of age or younger. We do not intentionally collect or maintain data about anyone under the age of 13.

3. How we use the information we collect

We use the information we collect for a variety of ways in providing our service, including the following:

3.a) Operations

We use information to operate and enhance all features of this website, to provide services and information requested by visitors of the website.

3.b) Improvements to the website

We use information to understand and analyse the preferences and user behaviour of visitors to this website. This allows us to improve the functionality of the service we provide and develop new services and features. All data used for this purpose is processed in an anonymised form.

3.c) Communications

We may use contact information to contact users of the website for administrative purposes, and with updates relating to the products and services we offer. You have the

ability to opt out of any promotional communication as per the section below, under 'Your Rights'.

3.d) Cookies and Tracking Technology

We use automatically collected information and other information collected on this website through cookies and similar tracking technology. This helps us to personalise our service, such as:

Remembering a user's information inputted on the website in previous visits, so that the user will not have to re-enter the information during subsequent visits

Provide personalised advertisements, content, and information

Monitor and analyse the effectiveness of the website and third party marketing activities

Monitor aggregate site usage metrics such as total number of visitors to the website or pages viewed

Track your entries and submissions on the website.

4. How long we hold your data for

We will only hold your information for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy. We may also retain log files for analysis purposes – these log files are generally retained for a short period of time, except in cases where the information is used for website security, improving the website functionality, and in the cases in which we are legally obligated to retain information for longer time periods.

5. How we protect your data

We take security very seriously and are committed to keeping your information safe. Whilst we endeavor to ensure the security of our systems and the information we hold, no service is guaranteed to be completely secure. If you have any concerns that your personal information has been put at risk, please get in touch straight away.

6. When your information is shared with others

We will never sell your personal information. We may share it with others in the following ways:

6.a) When we use other companies to provide a service

We work with third party services who provide website development, hosting, maintenance, and other services for us. These third parties may have access to or process personal data as part of providing these services to us. We limit the information provided to only what is reasonably necessary in order to perform these functions, and require them to handle your personal information as if we were handling it directly.

6.b) Non-personally identifiable information

We utilise aggregated, or otherwise non-personally identifiable information for a number of purposes, including measuring and analysing site usage, system administration, and improving our site. We may also disclose this non-personally identifiable information to third parties, including advertisers, vendors, and researchers.

6.c) Compliance with law

We may disclose personal information if required to do so by law, or to otherwise cooperate with law enforcement or governmental agencies.

We reserve the right to disclose personal data in order to take precautions against liability, or protect ourselves or others from fraudulent or unlawful uses or activity.

7. Your Rights

You have the right to:

Request a copy of the information we hold on you

Ask us to correct, delete, or only use your information for certain purposes.

Change your mind at any time and ask us to stop using your information – for example, by unsubscribing to marketing emails or opting out of cookies.

The exceptions to these rights include: When access to personal data would reveal personal information about another individual, or if we are legally prevented from disclosing such information. In addition, we may retain data even if you withdraw your

consent, where we can demonstrate that we have a legal requirement to process your data.

8. Links to other websites

This website may contain links to other websites which are outside of our control and, as such, are not covered by this privacy policy. If you access another website via a link on this site, the operators of these sites may have collected your information in accordance with their own privacy policies.
