

# Choosing the Page Template

There are a variety of different page types that you can choose on a Google site. The page types are called templates.

There are a couple of different ways to choose the page type.

When you create your page you can choose what type of page that it will make. When you name your new page, if you click the drop down arrow next to web page, it will show all the different types you can choose from. If you do not choose at this point, the default type is “web page”.

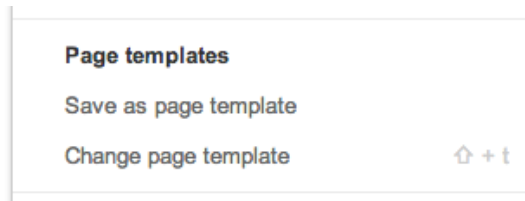

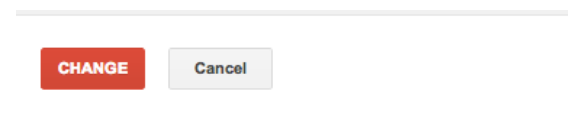
If you have already made a page and want to change the template, you can do this via the “more “ menu on your site page.

On the more menu, you need to click on “Change page template”



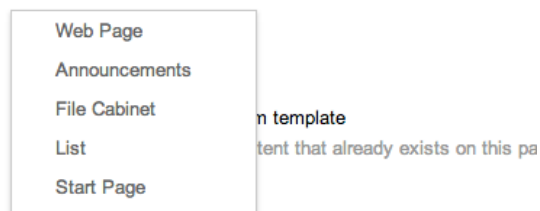
This will bring up the same drop down menu with the options on.

Click on the one you want then click on the big red change button.
