

Ed Tech Substitute Tips

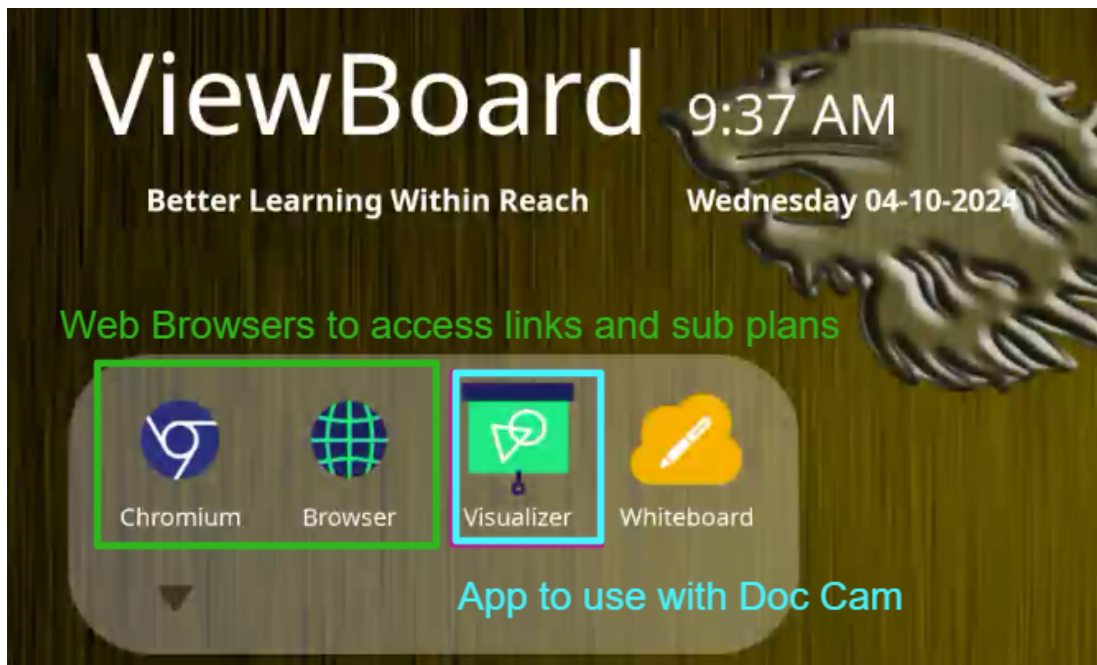
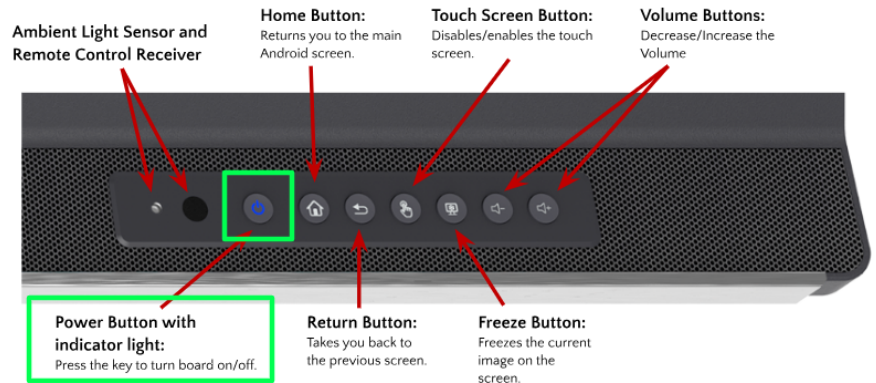
Spring 2024 (updated 4/10/24)

The classroom teacher may have left you a paper, hard copy of instructions for the day. If they left you a short URL (shortened web address) that may be accessed on the Viewboard or a student laptop (once they arrive).

To access a short URL, you will turn on the Viewboard by clicking the power button on the front right hand side. It will be the first button on the left as you scan left to right.

Once the board is on, treat it as if it is a large tablet. Touch one of the two web browsers to launch an internet browser page so you can type in the short URL and access the digital file the teacher has prepared for you.

Control Panel Buttons On The Bezel (52 Series)



If necessary, you could also plug a **student device** into the Viewboard if you need to access secured content. You use the usb-c cord on the front right of the viewboard. This is compatible with all Chromebook devices.

I/O Panel Ports On The Bezel (52 Series)

USB Type-C:

Front facing input port, connect to the external PC with USB Type-C output.

HDMI:

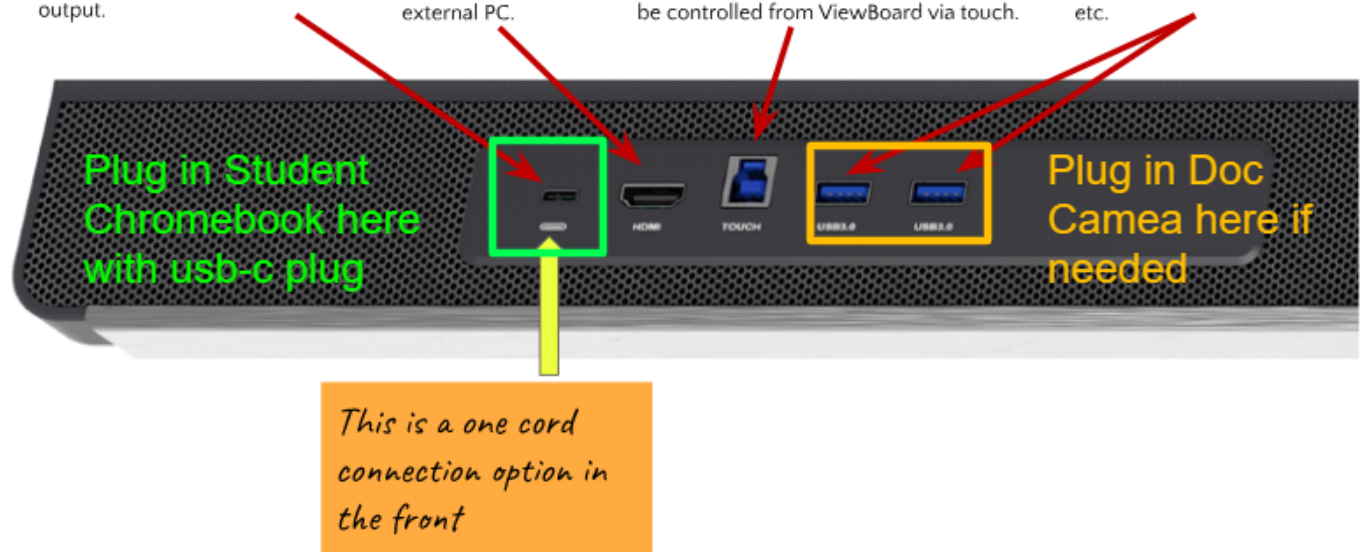
Transmits video and audio signals from an external PC.

USB Type-B:

Touch signal output to external PC. After connection, the external device can directly be controlled from ViewBoard via touch.

USB 3.0 (x2):

Front facing ports enable use of memory sticks etc.



Doc Cam - you can plug the doc camera directly into the front or side USB ports if it is needed for today. They will access the Doc Camera with the Visualizer App on the home screen of the Viewboard.
