- I found that picture of you from 1977, standing in front of an old windmill with your friend.
- You went there, and it was a bad idea. Your friend and the windmill both disappeared into thin air.
- Her sister was holding the camera. She took another picture minutes later; just you, no windmill, and no friend.
- You married her sister, and years later, your friend was reborn as your daughter.
- Your wife won't admit this is true, but I know it, because I found the evidence.
- Your friend never returned with you, and the windmill was gone. I went to see it myself. Where is it? What did you do?

1988:

This is the year that Micheal Hammond was born, according to his gravestone. This is the earliest date referenced in the videos.

1995:

This was the year that Micheal Hammond died, according to his gravestone.

1996:

There is a note by Rainer that says: "This is my present for you. I started it in 1996, for Marvin." in Petscop X. This gift may refer to the Petscop game itself, the recordings, or something else. If it is referring to the Petscop game, one would assume it was started in 1996. This means that the game was created after Micheal died, which is interesting since Toneth's description references Micheal's reaction to seeing Toneth: ("Funny stupid blob monster" says Mike.) So maybe Rainer started working on the "Even Care" part of the game before Mike's death, but after Mike died, he abandoned the Pet capturing aspects and instead worked on the darker parts of the game.

1997:

In Petscop 1, Paul mentions a note that he found attached to the game. It was written as:
6/13/97

For you:

Please go to my website on the sticker and also go to roneth's room and press start and press down down down down right start

2004:

Paul's Mom had it reportedly.
