An **oxymoron** is a pair of adjacent contradictory terms, such as “seriously funny” or “found missing”.

**Adroit:** skillful; good at doing something. Example: Watchmakers have to be adroit because they work with small devices, precise tools, and complicated mechanisms. I assume that they are paid well for their skills.
