Countesswells Primary School

It is disappointing that we cannot access the primary school for events/meetings. We have written to the council regarding this as despite going backwards and forwards with facilities team we are unable to access school unless we cover a huge cost.

The school grounds need looked at and now we have map of boundary of school and who is responsible for this.

Dog Mess

After Littler Pick recently we again had to pick up a number of dog poo bags and noticed a significant amount of poo not bagged around the development. This is not acceptable. It is responsibility of dog owners to pick up any mess left by dog.

We are looking into a campaign such as Pink Poo by Chester City Council as a community event. Dog Warden has been emailed to see what initiatives we could get involved with. NES have been working with council to facilitate on the spot fines.

Pavement Parking

There has been more reports of inappropriate parking on pavements. This has been reported to council but until roads are adopted they cannot do anything. We have reported the pavement parking to Osprey housing for the houses that were recently built.

Badgers
