Player Development Focuses

- Edgework This is crucial for improving speed, agility, and balance. We'll work on tight turns, quick starts, and stops to make players more dynamic on the ice.
- 2. Puck Skills From stickhandling in tight spaces to passing accuracy, puck control will be a major emphasis. Players will work on receiving passes under pressure and handling the puck efficiently in all situations.
- 3. Shot Strength Players will practice different types of shots (wrist shot, slap shot, snap shot) and learn proper techniques to increase shot power and accuracy.
- 4. Hockey IQ Beyond physical skills, hockey IQ will be a focus. This means understanding positioning, timing, reading plays, and making decisions quickly under pressure.
- Player Evaluation I'll be conducting assessments both at the start and during the season to track progress, identify areas for growth, and develop personalized training plans for each player. Regular feedback and drills will ensure consistent improvement.

Team Development Focuses

 Fundamentals Review – While we continue to develop advanced skills, we'll constantly revisit and reinforce basic hockey concepts such as positioning, puck protection, and communication. Mastery of the fundamentals is key to advancing our game.

2. Special Teams:

- Power Play We'll implement a structured power play system, focusing on quick puck movement, player positioning, and creating scoring opportunities.
- Penalty Kill Emphasis on positioning, clearing the puck, and aggressive but controlled pressure to prevent goals.
- Faceoff Strategies Teaching players how to win key faceoffs and how to position themselves
 effectively in faceoff situations, both offensively and defensively.
- 3. Breakouts & Transitions Efficient breakouts and smooth transitions between defense and offense will be a focal point. We'll work on making quick, accurate passes and supporting each other as a team.
- 4. Battle Drills Developing the ability to win puck battles in the corners, along the boards, and in front of the net. This will improve overall competitiveness and physicality.
- 5. Heads-up Hockey Teaching players to constantly scan the ice, anticipate plays, and make smart decisions with and without the puck. This will be a huge part of improving hockey IQ.

Overall Team Philosophy

We're aiming for continuous improvement through focused drills and individual accountability. Teamwork, communication, and effort will be at the core of everything we do. Together, we'll work on sharpening our skills and strategies to not only elevate individual performances but also strengthen our collective team play.

Communication Philosophy

Each coach, player, and parent should have a voice in the process. As a coach, my responsibility is to provide each player with a program that not only helps improve their individual skills but also strengthens the team's collective abilities. I am committed to offering clear and effective instructions that will best support that goal.

Encouraging open communication between players is essential for building strong relationships and fostering teamwork both on and off the ice. I believe that developing these 'on ice' connections enhances the overall experience and success of the team.

Furthermore, I maintain an 'open door' policy for players and parents, ensuring that everyone feels comfortable sharing their thoughts, comments, and concerns. Together, we can work to create a positive and collaborative environment where everyone is supported and empowered to succeed.

Schedule & Time Commitment:

I understand that at this age, players may have other commitments such as school or work. I will do my best to accommodate everyone's schedule, ensuring that all players can participate to the fullest extent possible.

Practice Schedule:

- Weekly Practices: 1 practice per week.
- Additional Practice: Extra practice every other week.(TBD)
- **Dry Land Training:** Schedule to be determined (TBD).

Event Arrival Times:

- Games: Players are expected to arrive 45 minutes prior to the start of the game.
- **Practices:** Players are expected to arrive **15 minutes prior** to the start of practice.

Tournaments:

- Players are expected to participate in a minimum of **2-3 tournaments** throughout the season:
 - 1 Away Tournament
 - 1-2 Local Tournaments

Budget Plan for the 2025/26 Season:

The proposed budget for the upcoming season will be approximately \$700-\$800 per player. This budget will cover various team expenses, including:

- 1. Tournaments:
 - o Approx. \$1500 per tournament (for both home and away tournaments).
- 2. Possible Home/Away Jerseys:
 - Costs will be determined based on the jersey options chosen.
- 3. Dryland/Development Training:
 - o Funds allocated for extra training sessions aimed at player development.
- 4. Sponsorship:
 - Expected sponsorship income: \$1500.
- 5. Team Tools:
 - Equipment and resources necessary for team activities.

Payment Breakdown:

- Player Registration Fees:
 - o To be paid at the beginning of the season to cover initial costs.
- Subsequent Fees:
 - Additional fees for tournaments, development, and extracurricular events will be determined before the start of the season.
- Sponsorship & Fundraising:
 - The amount of funding from sponsors and fundraising will help reduce the overall player expenses. We will adjust the budget accordingly based on these contributions.
- Payment Schedule:
 - Parents will be required to make a partial payment at the time of registration, which will cover the first tournament and possibly away jersey costs.
 - Quarterly payments will be required throughout the season
