

Dear students,

Some of your instructors may allow you to earn (extra) credit by participating in research. Here's how you go about doing so. Note that the below **only applies to courses offered in UF Linguistics, Spanish & Portuguese Studies, and Speech, Language and Hearing Sciences(!)**. Note that psychology and other departments use a different SONA system, so please make sure you do the below even if you have an account on other SONAs!

(1) If you have not used the ufl-slhs SONA before, create an account on <https://ufl-slhs.sona-systems.com/>

(2) login and complete a short pre-screening. You only need to do this pre-screening once per semester.

(3) select a study and sign up for a time slot. Check again later if you do not see studies or timeslots you can participate in

(4) you will automatically receive credit after you have completed the research session. If you do not see this in your SONA account, please contact the experimenter. Do NOT give the informed consent form to your instructor! Instructors will be able to see at the end of the semester how many credits you have earned for their courses.

(5) You can **re-assign the SONA credits you earned across the various courses** you are enrolled in. See the video under (1).

(6) If you do not want to be in studies, or do not qualify for any, please ask your instructor for an alternative assignment.

(7) check the study listing and SONA regularly, since the study listing will change over the semester.
