Nancy	RPM for HDP Updates	May 5, 2025 is go-live date for SSM St. Mary's Madison. Currently the work team is working through insurance authorization workflows to avoid delays for starting the BP monitoring through SSM Health at Home once they are discharged after their pp stay. It will be offered to patients with preeclampsia with severe features initially for 1-2 months, then it will be offered to all patients with HDP, goal is to offer it in SSM WI region and all of SSM.
