Subject: Current Identity and Commitments of Ohio Conference

Now that we are in the middle of our two-year review process and in preparation for our 2023 Annual Conference Assembly where there will be continued discernment with the goal of making a decision together regarding future affiliation, the Leadership Team would like to clarify our identity and commitments as a conference of Anabaptist and Mennonite Churches in Ohio, northwest Pennsylvania and southeast Michigan. Our current identity and commitments will stay the same whichever affiliation option we may choose:

- We are committed to living into our new mission statement of *Gathering, Equipping and Sending our congregations by the power of the Holy Spirit to live out God's Greatest Commandments* (loving God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength and loving others as ourselves *and Jesus' Great Commission* (going out and making disciples of Jesus Christ).
- We fully support the 1995 *Confession of Faith in a Mennonite Perspective* (Ohio Conference Constitution and 2015 Resolution).
- While we recognize that Ohio Conference's credentialed ministers, delegates, and congregational members are in different places on the interpretation of Scripture regarding LGBTQIA+ persons, we continue to hold our credentialed ministers accountable to the resolution passed by our delegate body in 2015 that our credentialed ministers will not perform a same-gender ceremony/marriage or be in a same-sex relationship themselves.
- We are committed to continuing our two-year process of discerning God's will for us as a Conference which includes affiliation, as well as vision and structural change reflective of our new mission statement.
- We are committed to continuing our current initiatives of anti-racism training and intercultural development, immigration, empowering women in leadership, and educating and equipping our pastors and congregational leaders in missional theology and action.
- We are committed to doing life together as sisters and brothers in Jesus Christ for the glory and honor of his name.
