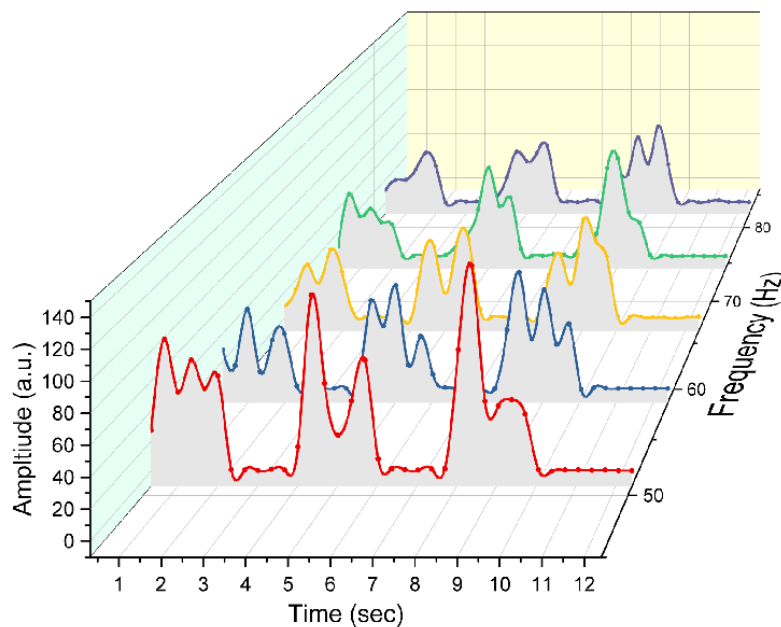

Chart 2 Infant Mortality Rate vs National GNP and Literacy Rate



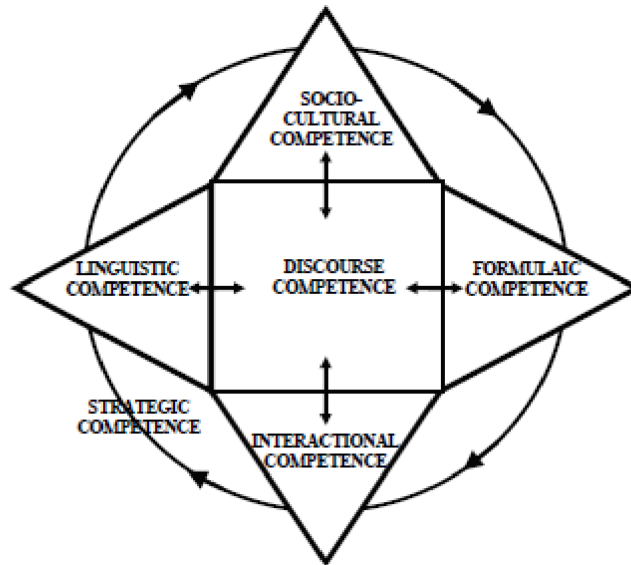


Figure 3 Revised schematic representation of 'communicative competence
