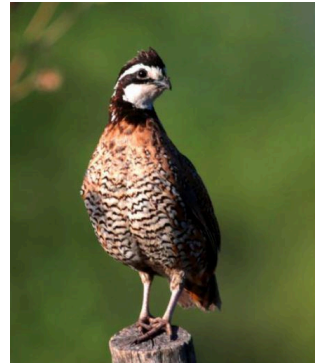


Bringing Back Bobwhites in Southern Maryland
