## Calendar Information

Although PSD Options tries to follow the district calendar as much as possible, we do have a difference in our semester end date for this fall. PSD Options 1st semester will end on Friday January 13th, and the second semester will start on Friday January 20th. This means that afternoon classes for 3rd-8th grade students will change on January 20th, and not at Winter Break.

## Breakfast Availability for Students

PGA & PSD Option have worked with PSD's Child Nutrition Team to be able to offer breakfast this year. Starting on Friday 9/23, when students order a school lunch for the current school day, they will have the option to also order breakfast for the following day. During lunch on Friday, any students that ordered breakfast will be given a brown bag that includes shelf-stable food. Breakfast is \$1.50 for students, \$2.35 for adults, and free for

students that qualify for free or reduced lunch and have completed the necessary application for this year.
