

Student Parking Standards Guidelines

Just like driving is a privilege, so is parking on campus. Irresponsible actions and endangering the lives and safety of others will not be tolerated. Permits must be displayed at ALL times and students must park in their appropriate area.

When issued a parking permit you are expected to fully comply with the following Parking Rules and Regulations:

- 1. All automobiles must be registered with the Administration. Vehicles not registered can be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
- 2. Parking on school grounds during school hours is by PERMIT ONLY.
- 3. Parking permits must be hung from the rearview mirror of the vehicle while parked on school grounds.
- 4. Student parking is RESTRICTED solely to areas designated for student parking. Students are not permitted to park in any areas for staff or visitor parking.
- 5. Parking permit is non-transferable to other students.
- 6. A parking permit may be revoked if a student is absent or tardy ten or more days in a quarter.
- 7. Reckless driving will result in an immediate loss of parking privilege.
- 8. Parking in the school lot is a privilege not a right; if it is not used responsibly, it will be withdrawn
- 9. Permission to drive to school covers the driver only and does not include transporting other students UNLESS parent authorization has been given by parent/guardian of both the driver and the passenger.
- 10. The student driver should immediately notify the school of any changes of vehicles. The driver will also immediately notify the school of any change in license plate numbers.
- 11. If a permit is lost, the student must secure a new permit at a fee of \$15.00.
- 12. State laws concerning safe driving will be enforced. Buses and pedestrians have the right of way at all times. STUDENTS MUST REPORT TO ADMIN, SRO OR SECURITY ASSISTANT ANY ACCIDENT THAT OCCURS ON SCHOOL PROPERTY. FAILURE TO DO SO, MAY RESULT IN PARKING PRIVILEGES BEING REVOKED.

PARKING VIOLATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. THE ADMINISTRATION RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REVOKE PARKING ON CAMPUS PRIVILEGES.
