I. Introduction

Authors are suggested to present their articles in the section structure: INTRODUCTION - METHOD - RESULTS AND DISCUSSION – CONCLUSION. The discussion should provide a bridge between results and the literature review in introduction. Please be sure that the citations are up to date. All the citations should be listed in the references. It is expected that the citations are at least 10 sources. The authors are required to submit at least 6 pages article including references

II. Page Layout

A. Page Layout

The paper must use a page size corresponding to A4 which is 210mm (8.27") wide and 297mm (11.69") long. The margins must be set: top = 19mm (0.75"), bottom = 28mm (1.1"), left = Right = 14.32mm (0.56").

III. Page Style

All paragraphs have a justified format, i.e., both left-justified and right-justified. First sentence in the paragraphs must be indented.

A. Text Font of Entire Document

The entire document should be Times New Roman at 11 points in size. Other font type and size may be used **if needed** for special purposes. Recommended font type and sizes are shown in Table 1.

B. Title and Author Details

The title and author's name must be Times New Roman with a font size of 18 and 12, respectively. Author affiliation and associated email must be Times New Roman in size 9 and italics. Every word in a title must be capitalized except for preposition such as “a”, “an”, “and”, “as”, “at”, “by”, etc. Author details must not show any professional title (e.g., Managing Director), any academic title (e.g., Dr.) or any membership of any professional organization. The family name must be written as the last part of each author name.

C. Section Headings

The headings are no more than 3 levels. All headings must be in 10pt capitalized font except for the preposition.

- 1) *Level-1 Heading:* A level-1 heading must be in Small Caps, and numbered using uppercase Roman numerals. For example, see heading “III. Page Style” of this document. The two level-1 headings which must not be numbered are “Acknowledgment” and “References”.
- 2) *Level-2 Heading:* A level-2 heading must be in Italic, left-justified and numbered using an uppercase alphabetic letter followed by a period. For example, see heading “C. Section Headings” above.
- 3) *Level-3 Heading:* A level-3 heading must be indented, in Italic and numbered with an Arabic numeral followed by a right parenthesis. The level-3 heading must end with a colon. The body of the level-3 section immediately follows the level-3 heading in the same paragraph. For example, this paragraph begins with a level-3 heading.

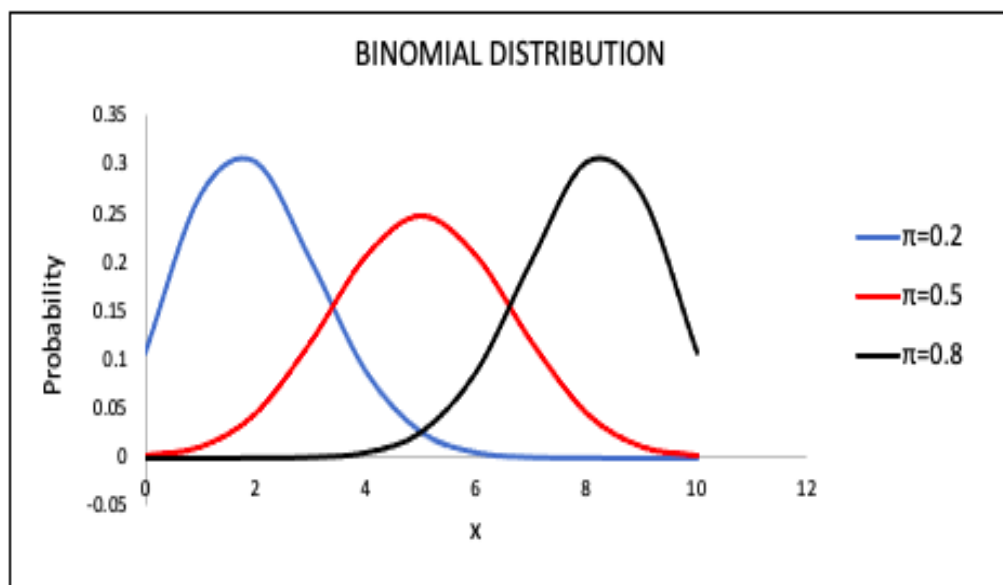


Figure 1. A Sample Line Graph using Colors Which Contrast Well Both on Screen and on a Black-and-white Hardcopy

D. Figures and Tables

Figures and tables should be centered. The figure is allowed to be colorful. Please ensure that the colors in the figures contrast clearly both on screen and on the black-and-white hardcopy, as shown in Fig. 1. The image resolution must be sufficient to reveal important details in the image.

E. Figure Captions

Numbering figures is using Arabic numerals with text captions should be centered with Times New Roman with a size of 8 points.

F. Table Captions

Tables must be numbered using uppercase Arabic numerals and their captions must be centered and in 8 pt Regular font with Lowercase. Every word in table captions must be capitalized except for short minor words as listed in Section III-B. Captions with table numbers must be placed before the corresponding table, as shown in Table 1.

G. Page Numbers, Headers and Footers

Page numbers, headers and footers must not be used.

H. Links and Bookmarks

Please not apply hypertext links and section bookmarks

I. Equations

Equations should be placed flush-left with the text margin. Equations are centered and numbered consecutively starting from 1 as follows

$$E(F) = E(0) + \sum_i \left(\frac{\delta E(F)}{\delta F_i} \right)_0 F_i \quad (1)$$

For case of equation system or more than one equation, keep it centered but make them left-aligned with one number.

$$\frac{dy}{dx} = ax + by$$

$$\frac{dy}{dx} = cx + dy \quad (2)$$

J. References

There is not number for the heading of the References. All reference items must be Times New Roman at 8 points in size. Please use Regular and Italic styles to distinguish different fields as shown in the References section. Number the reference items consecutively in square brackets (e.g. [1]). The examples of reference items of different format are given in the end of this template.

The conclusion consists of a summary of the discussion and its implications for further research or its relevance to other fields
