

# Analysis - Workshop #2

## Overview of all designs

*First round:*

1. Screen/whiteboard (i.e a google docs) on the doors of all apartments
2. Simple whiteboard on the washing machine
3. LED pulse lights on balcony
4. Sharing laundry cart (if you had extra room, you could invite others to join)

*Second room:*

1. Scanning book case
2. Share Pear
3. Mail Ducts between apartments
4. Washing machine recorder

## Recording: Designøvelse 1, hold 1

**Design activity 1:** Frey & Lea// Andrea & Anne

### Common area

*Choose object* (Also considered Stove & Fridge)

**Door:** using a screen or LED to communicate events

- Screen: can have advanced images
- LED: more interactive; people have more of a response.
- “High-tech” whiteboard (a google docs screen); write something, anyone can see.
  - Communicate events; write notes for other apartments.
  - Each apartment has a user.
  - Simplest: one whiteboard, everyone shares it.
  - More complicated: one shared; one for each apartment. Other apartments can't change it.
  - Private + public messages.
    - Between apartments and publicly to all.
  - Include emojis - drawing. **A drawing board, rather than normal text.**
  - **As simple as possible, if too complex, people won't interact with it.**
  - Adding a link, to a website, that gives more opportunities.
  - Can send messages? Send txts to all?
    - Too similar to facebook. - rather than people, its **apartment profiles**.
  - Add profiles vs. making it anonymous. ?
  - Too intimidating to show up at someone's place where you don't know anyone?

### Laundry Room

You can book times, but it doesn't work. Bad system.

Want to work with the **washing machine:**

- A screen on the machine? Don't have to see what is being washed either.
- A recorder in the washing machine.
- LEDs that light up -color coded?
- **White board on the machine (Could be misused). - extremely simple.**

- Leaving messages: “ill be back to get it my clothes \_\_\_\_ minutes”
- If it had seating spots, table etc., then it would be more interactive/social.

## Recording 4

### **Fridge:**

Food expiration: What to make with your left overs. I have some food left I’m not gonna use. “there’s this much milk available for use on 3rd floor apartment B”blab la bla. To avoid screen: audio recording. Microphone. Box in the kitchen – size: not too big and not too small. Installed! Otherwise it will disappear. If it’s on the wall you might use it for other purposes. No direct communication: LED on top when there’s a message. “Minimalist pear design” “Hey SharePear! – message”  
Motion sensor

Size: not that big, should be able to carry it and move it.

### **Book shelf:**

Scanning the book, when you put it up. You can leave a review, comment, tips, invites to talk about it. Scanner – screen. The screen could look like a book. “Pernille made a review. She want to discuss chapter 6 – Get in contact with Pernille here!”

### **Laundry cart:**

Everyone uses it. Notifying people about the fact that you are doing your laundry = “come join”. Communicative socks “I’m doing laundry, I have some space left in the machine” – too time consuming.

### **Book case:**

aren’t using it. Social atmosphere around the book case.  
In the back corner – not approachable

### **Chrome Cast**

### **Clothes rack**

“**Flap**” – light outside door that would light up, if you want to hang. Send out a message to apartment/building.

**Party-Beacon.** Light within a tube. Presses a button and it pulses. Following something where you don’t know where you end up. On the balcony – light waves between apartment. Transmitter of the search for companies
