AGRICULTURE ON THE NORTH COAST

Since early settlement, agriculture has always been important on the North Coast. Many industries that were first established have continued to be important and are known as traditional industries. They include dairying, beef cattle raising, pig production, sugar cane growing, and banana growing.

Rapid change occurred in agriculture in the 1970's. A lot of newer agricultural enterprises were set up. <u>Current</u> industries include macadamia nut growing, coffee, fish farming, herb and flower growing (see graph).

Today's agriculture contributes over \$650 million to our economy and this rises to \$1 billion when processing is included, particularly in meat, sugar cane, milk and macadamias.

Approximately 1 in 12 working people are employed in agriculture. Again this is higher when processing is included. Many more people work for agricultural suppliers, transporters, and machinery centres in the region.

The contribution of agriculture to the region is immense.
