Long title	A Procedural Resolution to reduce the number of DEI trainings that are required in the Spring/Summer session.
Author Summary	This resolution changes the Compiled Code to reduce the amount of DEI training in the Spring/Summer session. It makes it so the DEI Coordinator is only required to host at least three DEI trainings in the Fall and Winter semesters. In the Spring/Summer session, the DEI Coordinator will only be required to host one DEI training. Members of CSG will still be required to attend one DEI training each semester, however, in the Spring/Summer session, they may attend other DEI trainings that are hosted outside of CSG, with approval of the DEI Coordinator.

WHEREAS,

CSG recognizes the importance of DEI trainings; AND,

WHEREAS,

However, during the Spring and Summer, there is limited time for the DEI coordinator to plan and facilitate three DEI trainings; AND,

WHEREAS,

It is more efficient for the DEI coordinator to plan and facilitate one DEI training and allow members to have the option of attending DEI trainings outside of CSG; AND,

WHEREAS,

This eliminates stress from the DEI coordinator while still maintaining CSG's beliefs that DEI is crucial to our institution.

THEREFORE it is, by the Students of the University of Michigan, through Central Student Government:

8. Trainings ...

8. 4 DEI Training- The Central Student Government at the University of Michigan will hold at least three DEI training sessions [during the Fall and Winter semesters, and at least one DEI training session during the Spring/Summer session](#) ~~per semester~~, lasting at least one hour each, for all members of the Executive, Assembly, Interns, and Judicial branches, including interns under the First Year Internship Program. The DEI Coordinator will host and plan DEI training sessions. Members of the Executive, Assembly, and Judicial Branches (including interns under the First Year Internship Program) will be required to attend at least one DEI training per semester. [During the Spring/Summer semesters, this DEI training can be hosted by an organization outside of CSG but must be approved by the DEI coordinator.](#)

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
