Year 12 Graduation (19th Sept)

Sydney Town Hall has been booked, however, there is still no word back from the Council regarding the request for a fee reduction. The starting time has been set at 5:00pm to enable an early finish before dinner. General discussion in the meeting was that a 6:00pm start would be better to give parents more time to get there after work. 7:00pm would be too late.

Strategic Plan

Each of the campuses is working on a three year Strategic Plan and these will be combined into a College Strategic Plan. The Plan is to be published at the end of term 4. The Principal will send out a survey to parents to gather input to this plan, based on the survey recently used by Balmain. She will send a draft to the P & C for review next week. The College Principal plans to hold a discussion session with parents on either 8th or 9th September 7:00pm - 8:30pm at Leichhardt Campus Library.

Family Holidays During Term

The Principal expressed concern about the relatively large number of students being taken out of school during term to go on family holidays. She stressed the importance of attendance at school for both Year 11 and 12. Coursework and assessments are are "full-on" and most students struggle to catch up if they miss a week or more of classes. Assessment is continual and contributes to the final HSC mark.

Last year there were some unfortunate incidents which resulted in a number of students being suspended. The Principal has issued a stern warning to Year 12 students this year.
