This resource is sponsored by Educate All Learners Alliance and will be held Wednesday, October 28th from 1 PM to 2 PM. The topic of the webinar will be, "Education Technology Resources to Support Students With or At Risk for Disabilities During COVID 19," The target audience is EC teachers, practitioners, administrators, parents, and stakeholders supporting special education learners during this remote or partially-remote experience. There will be an open Q & A from 2:00-2:15 PM.

Here is a brief description of the content:

During these unprecedented times, education technology has been called upon to play a central role to support teaching and learning. This webinar will feature short user-case video demos of five edtech resources that are ready now for use in special education, as well as conversations by practitioners and experts about the role of edtech in meeting the needs of children and students with or at risk for disabilities during the "new normal" in education.
