



Wentzville R-IV School District 1:1 Access Initiative "Insurance" Program

WSD Secondary student parents and guardians,

The district is offering an insurance program for your child's Access Initiative device (Chromebook). The cost to participate in this program is \$20 annually. Participation is optional. Coverage takes effect once payment is received, and the Access Initiative device is issued to your child. It is not retroactive. Buying into the program provides coverage only during the current school year, so from the time payment is received through the end of the school year which is June 30. The program fee is non-refundable and does not transfer to the next school year if the insurance is not used.

This Access Initiative insurance program will cover during the school year two replacements. The two items covered under this program are the LCD screen and keyboard replacement. The two items covered for that school year can be one screen and one keyboard, two screens, or two keyboards. Buying into this program does not cover devices that are lost, stolen, or needing to be totally replaced (\$254 for Chromebook, case is an additional cost). Any additional replacements after the first two that are covered, then the student will be charged a replacement fine for each subsequent screen or keyboard replacement.

Willful and deliberate damages to the device will cause the student to be charged with the replacement cost for the replacement part or the whole device (full replacement \$254, case is an additional cost), and will not be covered under the insurance program, no matter the age of the device.

Payments must be made in the form of a personal check made out to the

Wentzville R-IV School District and turned into your child's school office or through the Focus online payment.

Chromebooks must always be within the protective case (6th-12th Grades).
