We took a look at data and engaged in work related to identifying reasons that some students are not performing on grade level. It was a good opportunity for our staff to dig into data and try to identify hindrances to our students' academic success.

T.I.P work day- On 4/8 myself Mrs. Cline, Mrs. Gerdes and Mrs. Kuehn took the day to work in house on our targeted improvement plan. This is something that we have to do each year to help set goals and identify issues within our SPED department. It is very similar to our CIP process but is specific to the SPED dept. and is conducted yearly as opposed to every 5 years like with the CIP process.

ESU chess tournament- We had about 20 students compete in the elementary chess tournament at the ESU on March 24th. The students had a great time competing against students from other local districts.
