

## Supply List

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### Paints - choose only one

Please choose only one type of paint medium to work with for this class:

- Acrylics
- Oils
- Watercolors

Do not purchase supplies for more than one paint type. Watercolor supply information appears after the Acrylic/Oil section below.

### If you choose Acrylics or Oils:

#### Paint Colors

You will need six 2-ounce tubes of paint in the following colors:

- Titanium White – bright white (like typing paper)
- Hansa Yellow or Lemon Yellow – yellow like a lemon
- Naphtol Red – Bright red like a fire engine
- Phthalo Green – Dark green like a cucumber
- Ultramarine Blue – Deep blue like a night sky
- Mars Black or Ivory Black

#### Brushes

Brushes may be made from natural hair or synthetic fibers. Natural hair is preferred, but synthetics are widely used and more affordable. Sets may be more cost-effective and offer a variety of sizes.

Recommended brush types:

- Small round brush (comes to a point)
- Medium flat brush (square top)
- Filbert brush (great for blending)
- Large wash brush

## Canvas

- Use canvas boards or panels – a total of six canvases or panels
- Average size: 9 inches by 12 inches

## Additional Supplies for Acrylic or Oil

- Standard-size palette knife
- Roll of wax paper
- Painter's tape
- Two plastic or paper cups
- Roll of paper towels

## Only for Oil Paint Users

- Small bottle of linseed oil
- Small bottle of Turpenoid (online students only)

## If you choose Watercolors:

### Watercolor Paint

Choose one:

- A set of watercolor pencils
- A set of watercolor paints in small tubes

### Watercolor Brushes

Watercolor brushes are designed to hold water and paint efficiently. You can purchase brushes individually or as a set. Best quality are sable brushes and budget-friendly brushes are synthetic fiber made from polyester or nylon.

You should have:

- At least one very small brush (comes to a point)
- Three to four additional brushes in small, medium, and large sizes (based on your paper size)

Examples:

- Spotter brush
- Rigger brush
- Round brush
- Flat brush

- Mop or oval brush
- Large wash brush

### **Watercolor Paper**

Use watercolor blocks or pads (about 15 sheets) in one of the following sizes:

- 4 inches by 6 inches
- 6 inches by 9 inches
- 9 inches by 12 inches

### **Additional Watercolor Supplies**

- Watercolor palette or well
- Painter's tape
- Two plastic or paper cups
- Roll of paper towels
