## **More Bad News and The Golden Ratio**



Kylie Jenner headed to her office contemplating the direction of her UCC stable. 2024 had not been a banner year. After starting out strong with a 23-7 record at UCC XXV in Japan, the year seemed promising. Even with a slight dip, going 22-8 at UCC XXVI in Columbia, the stable's trajectory looked positive. However, things took a turn for the worse as the Barbies struggled with the heat and humidity at UCC XXVII in Miami, finishing with a 17-13 record and losing three titles to the unstoppable party girls over at Amped.



Sin City Slugfest V was another bitter pill for Kylie Jenner to swallow, especially considering she herself sponsored the event. Her fighters laced up their gloves and went toe to toe with the best boxers in the UCC. When the event concluded, the Barbies had a dismal 5-11 record, with most of their losses coming against their hated rivals. This added another setback in what had already been a challenging year for the stable.

Brawls with the Awesome Aries and the Lost Wildcats didn't fare well for the Barbies either, with many fighters sustaining injuries and losing their favorite bikini tops. The Wannabees proved to be a persistent thorn in Kylie's side, particularly the fiery redhead *Francesca Capaldi*. The talented powerhouse backed up her taunts with her fists at Sin City Slugfest V, where she knocked out *Victoria Justice, Dove Cameron, Joey King,* and *Madison Beer*. Before these losses, Dove had spent 14 straight months as the top fighter in the UCC.

However, after her encounters with Vita, Dove found herself struggling in the top 50, far from any hopes of another Lightweight title shot. This move and the subsequent downturn in Dove's performance further exemplified the difficulties Kylie Jenner's stable faced throughout the year.

Kendall Jenner also saw her Middleweight title and her 21 fight win streak snapped. She regained the title against Marina Diamandis only to lose it again in Miami.

Kylie Jenner felt that another special event might help snap her stable out of the slump they were in. After considering options from her fighters, she decided to sponsor *The Baby Oil Brawl* event at the world-famous Whiskey a Go Go. Unfortunately, the event started off poorly for the Barbies. Kylie watched as her first four fighters lost in devastating fashion against their hated rivals. Madelaine Petsch lost her rubber match to former Barbie Katharine McNamara, and Victoria Justice saw her former bestie, Ariana Grande, make a comeback and win in sudden death. The event, intended to reinvigorate the stable, only added to their struggles.


Olivia Rodrigo made headlines when she was given an ultimatum after losing six out of her last seven fights. Although she managed to beat Haley Khalil, her struggles continued. Following this, Camila Morrone, feeling slighted for not being chosen by Rodrigo, challenged Kylie Jenner. Kylie promptly refused the challenge and instead chose Madelyn Cline to fight as her proxy. Camila accepted, with the caveat that if she defeated Kylie's chosen fighter, Kylie herself would have to enter the oil pit.





It required a significant comeback to avoid dropping five straight matches at her own event. The pressure was on Kylie to turn the tide and inspire her team with a decisive victory.


