##### Michael Dauphin, Assessor's Office Update (25 min)

- Only send mail when home's assessed value increases. Reassessments occur every other year (on odd numbered years).
- Assessor's office WANTS to get it right. Please appeal! Appeal process: appraiser from the office assigned to the neighborhood, will come and assist in taking pictures. Recent bids for work, photos, sales of comparable properties will assist. If you disagree with the decision, you can appeal to the Board of Equalizations, an independent board of citizens votes on the appeal. (you can begin an appeal at [appeal@stlouis-mo.gov](mailto:appeal@stlouis-mo.gov)) Informal appeals May 1-June 23. All Board of Equalizations appeals are due the second Monday in July!

- Collector of Revenue will allow pre-payment of your taxes- no fees or application. RETAF program – Real Estate Tax Assistance Fund – can assist with paying your taxes if you qualify!
