

Copy of John Ralls's Title Bond to Polly & William Jameson (Jamerson)

Know all men by these presents that I John Ralls of the County of Ralls in the state of Missouri for and in consideration of the sum of six dollars per acre for all my interest in the following described tract of land supposed to be forty eight acres I hereby grant bargain and sell unto Polly Jamerson and William Jamerson of the county and state aforesaid derived by decent from my father's estate and by purchase from William S. Ralls and William L. Freman situate and being in the county of Ralls and state aforesaid adjoining the land of Ony Carstarphen and Festus E Williams in Town 55, R5 and as the same cannot now be described by metes and bound I am to have the land surveyed before the deed is made and the interest hereby conveys is $\frac{3}{4}$ of the tract know as Ralls heirs which is accorded to the said Jamersons of having ??? \$216.17 cents in notes and executed their note for 71.83\$ bearing 10 percent interest which will be the full consideration and when paid ??? myself to execute and deliver to them a general warranty deed for my interest in the land aforesaid witness my heirs and seal this 27th day of Nov 1844
