

# BridgeMUN Media & Photography Policy

## Cambridge Rindge and Latin School (CRLS) BridgeMUN Model United Nations Conference

### I. Purpose

BridgeMUN may document conference activities through photography, videography, and digital media to celebrate delegate achievement, promote future conferences, and share educational experiences with the broader community.

This policy outlines how media will be collected, used, and shared, and establishes expectations regarding consent and responsible posting.

### II. Media Coverage

Official BridgeMUN media may include:

- Photographs of committee sessions
- Group photos and award ceremonies
- Videos of opening and closing ceremonies
- Social media posts highlighting conference activities
- Promotional materials for future conferences

Official conference media will primarily be shared through:

- Instagram: **@crls.mun**
  - Official conference hashtag: **#BridgeMUN**

### III. Consent

By registering for BridgeMUN, delegates and advisors acknowledge that:

- Conference sessions are public academic simulations.
- Photographs and videos may be taken in public committee spaces and ceremonies.
- Media may be used for educational and promotional purposes by BridgeMUN and CRLS.

If a participant does **not** consent to being photographed or recorded, they must:

1. Indicate this preference on registration materials (if applicable), and/or
2. Notify the Secretariat or a faculty advisor at the beginning of the conference.

BridgeMUN will make reasonable efforts to accommodate non-consent requests.

### IV. Responsible Social Media Use

BridgeMUN encourages delegates to share their conference experiences online in a respectful and responsible manner.

Participants posting on social media should:

- Use the official hashtag **#BridgeMUN**
- Tag the official account **@crls.mun**
- Ensure posts reflect professionalism and diplomacy
- Obtain consent before posting identifiable photos or videos of others
- Refrain from posting content that is inappropriate, harassing, or disruptive

All social media content associated with BridgeMUN must comply with the Code of Conduct and Anti-Harassment Policy.

## **V. Privacy and Safety**

Participants may not:

- Record private conversations without consent
- Share personal contact information without permission
- Livestream committee sessions without explicit authorization
- Post content intended to embarrass, harass, or target others

BridgeMUN reserves the right to request removal of social media content that violates conference policies.

## **VI. Press and External Media**

Any external media presence (e.g., school newspaper, local press) must:

- Respect student privacy and school policies
  - Follow all consent guidelines
- 

## **VII. Policy Violations**

Violations of this Media & Photography Policy may result in:

- Request to remove content
- Revocation of media privileges
- Removal from committee
- Dismissal from the conference
- Notification of school administrators
