ed a White House, there was Benjamin Banniker. They needed rubber and plastics, they had George Washington Carver. And let's not forget Elijah McCoy. Now they need someone to deal with AIDS. Here is Sebi."

All of these inventions, including the discovery of electricity, Sebi attributes to Black men in America.

"It was Banniker who discovered electricity through the use of copper and carbon," Sebi said. "But Benjamin Franklin got the credit for it."

The charge of dispensing medicine without a license has already been addressed and defeated in civil court. Sebi's attorney, Simeon Greenaway, a Black man Sebi says he's proud to have representing him, said the more serious charge of practicing medicine without a license, was to have been heard in May. But it was postponed to Sept. 27, in New York State Supreme Court.

"I'm not surprised by his (Abrams) actions." Greenaway stated. "It is consistent with most of the scientific research that has historically been suppressed by the medical community. But this time the attorney general proceeded on the er-

diagnosing, treating or prescribing for any products or procedures to aid in the diagnosis, cure, treatment or prevention of disease in humans or other animals. Attorney General Abrams failed to return our numerous calls for comment.

"There is a total lack of proof that he was practicing medicine within the meaning of the statue. And the claim of a cure came from individuals that had had these experiences and reported them. The institute merely echoed their sentiments," Greenaway said.

Sebi was also given 60 days to advertise in AmNews and the Village Voice, an offer of a full refund to consumers dissatisfied with any of his products or services.

"His deliberate objective was to create a lot of fear in the public mind," Greenaway stated. "What we are dealing with here is African American herbal folk medicine, and we feel that Sebi is within the tradition and feel that it is a valuable medical technique within the Black community."

Sebi contends the compounds he uses fall within a category the government considers GRAS (generally regarded as Reproduced with permission of the copyright owner. Further reproduction prohibited without permission.
