Development (Laurel Roussen)

- -Hitting clinic, shooting, skating
- -Development is not just on the ice; Dryland & Nutrition
- -We have a lot or resources in the community, need to utilize them

Ice Operations (Allison Healy)

- -Going to request our ice for the upcoming season ASAP
- -Will request morning ice for Development
- -Should know mid July what ice we will get and whats available
- -More evening ice will be available with the North Star ice schedule changing up

U18 Director (Colleen Hickey)

- -Wants to set strong dressing room boundaries right off the start of the season
- -Had many issues last year
- -Would like to start charging a deposit at registration, too many players don't return their jerseys. Maybe they just wear their own practice jerseys
- -Could have players sign out the jersey at the beginning of the year or take a deposit
- -Assign a parent to look after the jerseys every game

Female Director (Tasha Hall)

- -Would like new jerseys, most don't fit! Would like them to have a sense of team unity
- -Has the opportunity to have a BBQ fundraiser at the Golf Course, with the help of Tiger parents to fundraise for new jerseys.
 - Tasha to bring a proposal to the board for next meeting
- -Wants to look for sponsorship for the Tigers
- -Girls want to travel, needs to look into tournaments
- -Stars Tournament in Winnipeg could be an option

Equipment Director (Evan Bercier)

- -New lock on the equipment room, doesn't know who has keys and who doesn't
- -Will go through the equipment and do an inventory to see what each division needs
- -Will look for grants throughout the season
- -Would like to instate a jersey deposit

Registrar/ Publicity (Nicole Marques)

-Learning all the social media stuff, waiting on Hockey Canada to do the HCR courses

U7 Director (Martin Murphy)

- -Anticipating more numbers to register this season
- -Already recruiting coaches
- -Need more jerseys for next season, reached out to Tim Hortons

- -Would like to increase the female coaches in the U7 Division
- -Need more foam bumpers for circuit/ station drills, great for large number practices, will submit a proposal
