## Finding eBooks Using the Library Catalog Video Transcript

Reynolds Libraries provides access to eBooks covering a wide range of subjects. You can find eBooks for just about any topic you are researching. One way to find and access eBooks is by using Reynolds Libraries catalog.

Start from the library's homepage located at <u>library.reynolds.edu</u> and enter keywords in the library catalog search box that describe your topic.

I have entered the question, should the united states government enact stronger gun control laws? Let's execute this search.

The catalog retrieved plenty of articles but did not find any books. Keep in mind that if you enter a research question or a sentence that describes your topic, you may not retrieve any or few book results.

This time, I will try using just the primary keywords from this question which are "gun control" and "united states." I will place the keywords within quotes to find the exact phrase for both terms. Let's execute this search.

This time the catalog retrieved books but it also found articles and videos.

To limit your search, use the Filter my results menu options located on the right side of the screen. I will click on **Books and Media** under the *Availability* menu. This time the catalog eliminated articles but there are still videos in my results.

To limit this search further, I will click on **Books** under the *Resource Type* menu. This search eliminated videos but I still have print books in my results.

To limit this search further, I will click on **Full Text Online** under the *Availability* menu. Now there are only eBooks in my results.

I can also limit my search to recently published books. From the *Publication Date* menu, I will change 1996 to **2017** and click on the **Refine** button to limit my search to books published within the last 5 years.

Let's review the results.

To access any eBook, you can click on the **Online Access** link from the results list or to review more details about any book, you can click on the **book title**.

I am going to click on the book title, **How American Got its Guns: A History of the Gun Violence Crisis**.

If I scroll down any detailed record screen, I can review the book description or chapter titles which will give a better idea of what is covered in a book.

To access an eBook from the full record, click on the **ebook link** under *View Online*.

If you are accessing any eBook from a library database from off campus, and sometimes on campus, you will be prompted with a Virginia's Community Colleges login screen. Login with your **My Reynolds username and password**.

If you are accessing a book from **ProQuest eBook Central**, as in this case, you will also be prompted to select your institution from the **Institution Name menu**. Scroll down and select **J. SARGEANT REYNOLDS COMMUNITY COLLEGE**. Then click on the **CONTINUE** button.

When the initial screen appears for ProQuest eBook Central, you will have the option to read the book online or download the entire book in PDF format.

You will need to have the Adobe Digital Editions app loaded on your computer or mobile device to download the entire book in PDF format.

You also have the option to read a chapter online or download a chapter in PDF format. You don't need Adobe Digital Editions installed to download a book chapter in PDF format.
