

For Parents: How to View Students' Graduation Progress in PowerSchool

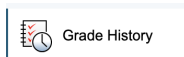
PowerSchool's Graduation Planner displays the student's progress towards Cache County School District's graduation requirements, as well as various scholarships and CTE pathways. Parents can view the progress in PowerSchool's Parent Portal allowing them to guide their students as they register for classes. Follow the steps below to view your student's progress in the graduation planner:

Log in to the PowerSchool Parent Portal (<https://powerschool.ccsdut.org/public>) using a computer or browser on your phone. (Not using the PowerSchool App.)

After you have logged in to the parent portal, click on the name of the child at the top for which you would like to view the graduation progress. (Graduation plans are only available for high school students.)

Click on the "Grade History" link in the left navigation.



Below the list of grades, there is a Graduation Progress button.

Graduation Progress

Click on that button and the Graduation Plan Progress page displays.

The first plan in the list is the CCSD Graduation Plan which lists all of the requirements set to graduate from high school.

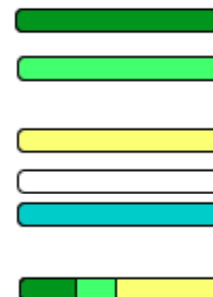
Specific graduation requirements are listed along with the credits required to meet that requirement. The progress made towards that requirement is displayed in the color bar on the right.

- If the bar is dark green, the graduation requirement has been met.
- If the bar is light green, the student is either currently in that class or will be later in the school year. If he/she passes that class, the graduation requirement will be met.
- If the bar is yellow, the student is registered for the course and will potentially take it next year.
- If the bar is white, no progress has been made towards that requirement.
- If the bar is blue, the counselor has waived that requirement because it has been met through other means.
- If the bar is multicolored, it means that more than one class is required to meet that requirement and the classes are in various stages of completion.



In addition to the CCSD Graduation Plan, you can find the student's progress towards the Opportunity Scholarship, the Prime Scholarship, the NCAA Qualifications, and various CTE Pathway Completion. Scroll down and you will see these other plans.
