\*WHO: School-aged children who have just completed kindergarten –  $7^{th}$  grade (elementary school age) Student-to-teacher ratio for camp – 10:1; for offsite events – 5:1

\*WHEN: Camp will meet Monday – Friday from June 3 through August 16; 8:00am-5pm

## \*COST: \$280/week, \$60/day

A \$20 deposit fee for each week will be charged when weekly registration is made. Remainder of the weekly fee will be charged the Thursday of each week before camp attendance.

Daily campers registered in advance will be charged on the Thursday before the week of attendance. When registering during the week of attendance, campers will be charged immediately upon registration. ALL billing is done electronically.

# \*What does your child need to have/bring for this camp?

- -On days of special events, we require a car seat for your child, if required by Iowa law.
- -Library cards may be desired, so checked out books can travel home. Otherwise they will stay at camp. Throughout day camp there will be other requests: comfy clothes, clothes that can get messy, etc. -They will have the opportunity to bring books from home for reading time, a pillow/blanket/special friend for rest time, and electronic devices will be allowed at various times during the day.
