**Artan Buleshkaj**, born in Istog (Kosovo) in 1993, is a guitarist and composer based in Ghent. He is active in projects in and outside of the bubbling music scene of the city, in a broad musical spectrum ranging from pop to (freely) improvised music.

#### **A selection of his current/active projects:**

- Anemic Cinema: Artan's own quartet featuring original compositions for Rob Banken (alto saxophone, clarinet), Steven Delannooye (tenor saxophone, bass clarinet) and Matthias De Waele (drums). Released debut-EP on el NEGOCITO Records (eNR 103, 2/04/2021). First full album "ICONOCLASTS" (Ramble Records) released on the 24<sup>th</sup> of February, 2023.
- Mos Ensemble (group led by bass player Kobe Boon): released CD/LP *Limbs* (Smeraldina/Rima) in January 2019, CD/LP *Behind the Marble* (W.E.R.F Records) in february 2022 and CD/LP *Pets & Therapy* (W.E.R.F. Records) in march 2024.
- DRIFTWD: band led by Sam de Bock and Patricia Vanneste. Artan joined the band in august of 2023 as the live guitarist. The band did a tour in 2024 with 3 American special guests: Tim Lefebvre (David Bowie, Elvis Costello, Tedeschi-Trucks band, ...), Donny McCaslin (David Bowie, Maria Schneider, ...) and Joey Waronker (Atoms for Peace, Beck, R.E.M., Roger Waters, Oasis,...). In september of 2024, the band released the LP *In Need of Music*, on which Artan makes a small appearance on the track *Erase*. The live album *A Mountain of Music* was released on the 20th of september 2025.
- Camera Obscura: trio led by Pierre Vaiana (soprano sax, compositions) with, in addition to Artan on guitar, also Lode Vercamp on cello. EP *Sur la Route de Valledolmo* (IGLOO Records) was released in april of 2024. Full album "Camera Obscura" was released in autumn '24, on IGLOO Records. Single "Yusuf" was released on IGLOO Records (6th of June 2025).
- Motian Love: group led by Nico Chkifi (drums), centered around the music of Paul Motian. Vitja Pauwels and Artan on guitar, Erwin Vann and Nicolas Kummert on tenor saxes. Album *Dance* was released on Ramble Records in october of 2024.
- Duo Decock-Buleshkaj: released album *Plain Songs* on vinyl (own management) in September of 2024. The album was included in the top 10 best jazz releases of 2024 by Focus Knack. Thomas and Artan are currently working on a follow-up album for this project, this time in quintet with Werend van den Bossche (alto and tenor sax), Yannick Peeters (double bass) and Lionel Beuvens (drums).

- Margritte: Dreampop-band led by singer-songwriter Margot de Ridder. Debut album *Gentle* (W.E.R.F. Records) released in november 2025.
- Songs to Aging Children: A tribute project centered around the music of Joni Mitchell. With Frie Mechele (vocals) and Zjef van Steenbergen (double bass).
- Trio Buleshkaj/Demeyer/De Waele: Organ trio focusing on jazz/boogaloo repertoire. They play pieces from the Great American Songbook, and originals.
- Cedric de Lat Quintet: new band led by Cedric de Lat (trumpet), with Lucia Pires (flute), Toon Rumen (double bass), Gert-Jan Dreessen (drums)
- Trio Verslype/Cornelis/Buleshkaj: music by Anke Verslype (drums), with Loni Cornelis (violin)

#### **A selection of his past/inactive projects:**

- Marta Rosa (dreampop-group led by Italian singer Marta del Grandi): released their debut record *Invertebrates* in 2016 and won the *Concourioso Pop Contest* in the same year.
- BRAIN//CHILD (jazzrock/noise-group, with members from Belgium and Italy): semi-finalist in the *Keep an Eye International Jazz Contest* Amsterdam. Released a CD in 2017 with *Honolulu Records*.
- Madame Blavatsky (electro/glitchhop-trio led by drummer Marius Couvreur): released debut EP *Gallium* in march 2017 and the single *Steak in the Neck* in 2018 (on compilation album *Jazz Cats*, *Sdban Records*). Released debut full album *Rocket Science* in 2020 (own management).
- Kids in the Waiting Room (pop group led by actor Thomas van Caeneghem): released first EP in april 2019.
- LAS (trio with cellist Lode Vercamp and tenor saxophonist Steven Delannoye): released album titled *Homonculus* in January of 2020.
- Amuri e Spiranza (quintet led by soprano saxophonist Pierre Vaiana): released album in april of 2020 with *Home records*.
- H A S T (jazz-rock group led by alto saxophonist Rob Banken): laureate of Theater aan Zee (2016) and kunstencentrum Kaap's "STORM!"-contest (2018), winner of the JazzTract-prize (Ghent Jazz 2017), released debut album *Elegy* (december 2018) + follow-up EP *Ubi Sunt* (february 2021) with *N.E.W.S Distribution/Solidude Records*.

#### **Other recordings/sessions/... featuring Artan:**

- *Avia*, Guest appearance for the artist Rosa Butsi (from her EP *Circle One*, released in september of 2020).
- *Stay*, Single by the artist Marta Del Grandi (recorded July 2021, released November 2022 on *Fire Records*).

- Selva, album by Marta del Grandi, recorded at Studio Ledeberg in February 2022, released on October 20th of 2023 on Fire Records. This album was “Considered for Grammy Nomination”.
- Played a concert with Donny McCaslin’s band (feat. Tim Lefebvre, Jason Lindner, Zach Danziger) during their album release tour for *Lullaby of the Lost*, at Paradox Tilburg, 17th of october 2025.
- Featured guest on album *Tales of a Six Cornered Snowflake*, by Tim Vermeulen Quartet (on the tracks “Voesh”, “Lullaby” and “Harmaj”). Album released in November 2025 (own management).

Buleshkaj was nominated in 2016 for the SABAM Young Jazz Talent Award and was a finalist of the B-Jazz International Jazz Contest (ed. 2015) with his jazz trio Ruis. He also was a jury member in the finals of aforementioned contest (ed. 2019 and 2022) In 2022, he was nominated for the *Young Jazz Talent Ghent*-prize with his quartet Code Poems. In 2018, he won the *Arts in Society Award* for a participatory art project he helped set up in WZC Het Heiveld in Ghent. He was also invited to play with the Brussels Jazz Orchestra, for “*The Future is Now*”, a concert series featuring young soloists. He studied with Hans van Oost (conservatory of Ghent) and Martijn van Interson (conservatory of Amsterdam) and also took private lessons with internationally renowned guitarists Lage Lund, Nir Felder and Gilad Hekselman. He is currently also teaching guitar and improvisation classes in the APK in Ghent. In 2025, he taught guitar and ensemble classes for a semester in the Conservatory of Ghent. Since 2022, Artan is also part of the artistic committee of the Ham Sessions in Ghent. He helps the festival with programming artists and outlining the artistic direction of the organization.
