 - State questionnaire form
 - State Counseling Session Form
 - College/s FERPA Form

for the college(s) you applied to.

□ 5. Registration.
Once you are accepted AND eligible then you will register for classes with your school counselor .
You will register for Fall courses in the Spring prior and register for Spring courses in the Fall prior.
-For Clark State: You should make an appointment with your counselor to go over the classes you want
to take outside of JAHS. If the course is at JAHS this is done during class scheduling in the Spring.
-For Columbus State: You will need to fill out the CSCC Registration Form and meet with your
counselor to register for classes.
 IF you are taking a CCP class at JAHS (in the building) we will register you for the class.
If you are taking an online or on campus class you will need to see your school counselor to
register.
 Clark State you may be able to register for the entire year.
