Drop Off 6:15 - 6:30 am

We will be running drop off through the back parking lot. As you pull into the parking lot, stay close to the quads. There will be cones to designate where cars should stop and let students out by the science classrooms. Please have your child ready to get out of the car quickly and efficiently. Once you have dropped off your child, please continue around the perimeter of the parking lot until you are back at the entrance/exit. Be careful pulling in and out of the parking lot. It is a tight fit when there are cars entering and exiting at the same time. Parents should NOT park in the back lot (with the exception of chaperones). As always when leaving please turn right at the light onto N. Druid Hills to help keep traffic flowing.

Pick Up 6:30 - 7:00 pm (estimated)

We are scheduled to leave Wahsega at 5:00 pm. Without traffic (ha!) we should return at 6:30 pm. Dr. Neely will send an email & text with updates on our estimated time of arrival. Please plan to arrive before our buses. Parents should park in the parking lot, only park in designated spots so there is space for the charter buses to navigate. Once all four charter buses have arrived and parked, exit your car and come and get your child. Again, please be cautious leaving the parking lot and turn right at the light onto N. Druid Hills.
