TO: All Local Unions, Central Bodies, Trade Councils, State and District Affiliated with the Idaho AFL-CIO;

Greetings,

You are hereby notified that in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution, the 68th Annual Convention of the Idaho State AFL-CIO will be held at the Crystal Ballroom, Hoff Building, 802 W. Bannock St, Ste 202, Boise, ID 83702 beginning at 10am Monday, June 15th, 2026, and will continue until the business of the Convention has been concluded on Wednesday, June 17th, 2026.

The number of delegates from a Local Union to the Convention shall be based on the average membership on which the Local Union has paid Per Capita tax during the preceding twelve (12) month period of April 1st through March 31st. Local Unions re-affiliated or Local Unions newly affiliated with the Idaho State AFL-CIO shall have their average membership divided by the number of months of affiliation during the preceding fiscal year. All affiliated organizations must have their Per Capita tax paid up to April 1st, 2026, in accordance with the Constitution, Article VI, Section 7 (a). Local Unions shall be entitled to representation on the following basis:

50 members or less – 1 delegate 50 – 100 members – 2 delegates
101 – 200 members – 3 delegates 201 – 300 members – 4 delegates
301 – 400 members – 5 delegates 401 – 500 members – 6 delegates

Plus, one additional delegate for each additional 250 members, or majority fraction thereof.

All affiliated organizations, other than Local Unions, shall be entitled to two (2) delegates each. DELEGATES REPRESENTING ORGANIZATIONS OTHER THAN LOCAL UNIONS MUST BE MEMBERS OF A LOCAL UNION AFFILIATED WITH THE IDAHO STATE AFL-CIO.

No Proxies shall be allowed. No delegates shall represent more than one (1) organization.

No delegate shall be entitled to a seat at the Convention who is not a member in good standing of the Union for which she/he presents credentials. Local Unions and Councils shall send delegate credentials to be received or postmarked by May 8th, 2026, to the Idaho AFL-CIO, 802 W Bannock St. STE 500, Boise, ID 83702. Payments postmarked after May 9th are subject to a \$50 late fee.

A RESOLUTION WAS PASSED AT THE 1974 CONVENTION GIVING THE EXECUTIVE BOARD POWER TO SET A REGISTRATION FEE. THIS FEE MUST ACCOMPANY EACH CREDENTIAL SENT TO THE OFFICE OR PRESENTED TO THE COMMITTEE ON CREDENTIALS UPON REGISTRATION AT THE CONVENTION.

No credential shall be considered valid bearing more than the name of one delegate and one alternate, provided, that if the alternate presents their credentials and is seated, they shall be the only recognized representative throughout the session of the Convention. A delegate presenting a letter signed by the President and Secretary of the Idaho State AFL-CIO and under seal of the organizations she/he is to represent stating that she/he is the substitute for the regularly elected delegate and alternate, may be seated by a majority vote of the delegates present.
