| | | Criteria #1: Body of Mug is Securely Made: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Relatively even thickness • Nearly invisible seams • The wall seam is secure and without cracks • a coil is run inside, around the base, where the walls meet the base (it is smoothed in) | |
| | | Criteria #2: Handle fits the Mug <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Securely attached • Big enough to fit at least one finger • Should be proportional to the size of the mug | |
| | | Criteria #3: Overall Clay Care <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimal cracks and crumbs on surface of clay • Most edges are smoothed, including handle • Top edge of mug is thinned, rounded, and smooth • Name/initials are on bottom of mug | |
| | | Criteria #4: Glazing <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Glazing is done with care, with minimal white spots where glaze was missed. | |
