Teams:

Division 1	Junior D , 12 years of age or less, may be unrated, teams of 3-4
Division 2	Senior D , 13 years of age and up, may be unrated, teams of 3-4
Division 3	Jr. Sr. C/H-B/B , 18 years of age or less, teams of 3-4
Division 4	B/H/H-HM/H-A/A , 14-25 years of age, teams of 2

All ages are as of January 1, 2025. A competitor does not have to meet championships qualifications to compete on a qualifying team. Divisions above are specific to our rally and are subject to change depending on registration numbers. These are not indicative of championship divisions. Competitors must be at least a D-2 and 10 years of age to qualify for USPC Championships at the time of the Rally. Click [here](#) for more Champs info.

Important Notes Regarding Invoices and Payments:

- Invoices and payment receipts are generated by the system and emailed to the member during the registration process.
- Entries must be paid by January 23rd or a 20% late fee will be added. Payment must be received before competitor may participate in the rally.

** VRPC members, if you have not renewed your membership, the system will not allow you to register for ANY regional activities. You will know you are not renewed if you see a "Membership has lapsed" link in the lower right corner of your screen when you log into www.vrponyclub.org. Click the link to renew. Then, you may proceed to register and pay for this activity.*

Attire:

Please dress warmly as all of Quiz this year will be in the indoor arena and the barns. There will be heated areas in the indoor arena and in the barns but most of the time, competitors will be in sheltered, but unheated areas.

- ❑ Testing phases will include Classroom, Written, Barn and Stations
- ❑ Competitors are required to wear a USPC or USEA Medical armband or Bracelet for the duration of the rally. In addition, since there is a barn phase, competitors are required to wear approved footwear.
- ❑ Only the team captain or appointed designee may pick up registration packets.
- ❑ Chaperones must carry the registration packet with them as the team moves through each phase. It is the chaperone's responsibility to ensure that no answer sheet leaves a completed phase with a competitor.
- ❑ Show your team spirit and be creative - we will once again have a team costume contest!

Volunteers:

Minimum of two volunteers, in addition to one chaperone, per team entry is required. Minimum of one volunteer per two scramble entries is required.
