    - Phil: It's something we can make good progress on in next week or two. The format and coding is one thing. A separate issue is how that changes the interaction with the data providers. The UK format could be less unwieldy for aspects of the process. There could be an alternative that achieves the same results.
    - Laura: We have a tentative call scheduled for November, could someone from the US NRP team attend?
    - Jenn: Yes, the person will depend on the nature of the call
    - Laura: we will give heads up we are having conversation with countries, and as follow up ask if someone from the US NRP team can join.
