Privacy Policy

This Privacy Policy describes our policies and procedures on the collection, use, and disclosure of your information when you use the service and tells you about your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

We use your personal data to provide and improve the service. By using the Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy has been created with the help of the [Free Privacy Policy Generator](#)

Interpretation and Definitions

Interpretation

The words of which the initial letter is capitalized have meanings defined under the following conditions. The following definitions shall have the same meaning regardless of whether they appear in singular or in plural.

Definitions

For the purposes of this Privacy Policy:

An account is a unique one created for you to access our service or parts of it.

Affiliate means an entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest, or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.

Application refers to MCCStream, the software program provided by the company.

Company (referred to as either "the Company," "We," "Us," or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Homeland Investors Inc.

Country refers to the United States.

Device means any device that can access the Service, such as a computer, a cellphone, or a digital tablet.

Personal data is any information that relates to an identified or identifiable individual.

Service refers to the application.

Service provider means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the company to facilitate the service, to provide the service on behalf of the company, to perform services related to the service, or to assist the company in analyzing how the service is used.

Third-party social media service refers to any website or any social network website through which a user can log in or create an account to use the service.

Usage data refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the service's use or from the service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

You refer to the person using the service or the company or other legal entity on whose behalf the person is using the service.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

We may request certain personally identifiable information from you during your use of our service, enabling us to contact or identify you. Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

First name and last name

Phone number

Usage Data

Usage Data

Usage Data is collected automatically when using the Service.

Usage Data may include information such as Your Device's Internet Protocol address (e.g., IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that You visit, the time and date of Your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

When you access the Service by or through a mobile device, we may collect certain information automatically, including, but not limited to, the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device's unique ID, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers, and other diagnostic data.

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our service or when you access the service by or through a mobile device.

Information Collected while Using the Application

While using Our Application, to provide features of Our Application, We may collect, with Your prior permission:

Information regarding your location is collected if you want to share location in chat

Information from your Device's phone book (contacts list); this is optional and collected only if you want to share contacts in the chat with friends

Pictures and other information from your Device's camera and photo library; this is optional and fetched only if you wanted to update profile picture, share image/video in chat, or share image/video in feed

We use this information to provide features for our service and to improve and customize it. The information may be uploaded to the company's servers and a service provider's server, or it may be simply stored on your device.

You can enable or disable access to this information at any time through your device settings.

Use of Your Personal Data

The Company may use Personal Data for the following purposes:

To provide and maintain our service, including to monitor the usage of our service.

To manage Your Account, we will oversee Your registration as a user of the Service. The personal data you provide can give you access to different functionalities of the service that are available to you as a registered user.

For the performance of a contract: the development, compliance, and undertaking of the purchase contract for the products, items, or services you have purchased or of any other contract with us through the service.

To contact You: To contact You by email, telephone calls, SMS, or other equivalent forms of electronic communication, such as a mobile application's push notifications regarding updates or informative communications related to the functionalities, products, or contracted services, including the security updates, when necessary or reasonable for their implementation.

To manage your requests: To attend to and manage your requests to us.

For business transfers: We may use your information to evaluate or conduct a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution, or other sale or transfer of some or all of our assets, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation, or similar proceeding, in which personal data held by us about our service users is among the assets transferred.

For other purposes: We may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns, and evaluating and improving our service, products, services, marketing, and your experience.

We may share your personal information in the following situations:

With Service Providers: We may share your personal information with service providers to monitor and analyze the use of our service and to contact you.

For business transfers: We may share or transfer your personal information in connection with, or during negotiations of, any merger, sale of company assets, financing, or acquisition of all or a portion of our business to another company.

With Affiliates: We may share your information with our affiliates, in which case we will require those affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy. Affiliates include our parent company and any other subsidiaries, joint venture partners, or other companies that we control or that are under common control with us.

With business partners: We may share your information with our business partners to offer you certain products, services, or promotions.

When you share personal information or interact in public areas with other users, that information may be viewed by all users and could be publicly distributed outside. If you interact with other users or register through a third-party social media service, your contacts on the third-party social media service may see your name, profile, pictures, and description of your activity. Similarly, other users will be able to view descriptions of your activity, communicate with you, and view your profile.

With your consent, we may disclose your personal information for any additional purposes you agree to.

Retention of Your Personal Data

The Company will retain your personal data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy. We will retain and use your personal data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The Company will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of our service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer times.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including personal data, is processed at the company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to—and maintained on—computers located outside of your state, province, country, or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ from those of your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this privacy policy, followed by the submission of such information, represents your agreement to that transfer.

The Company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy policy; no transfer of your personal data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place, including the security of your data and other personal information.

Delete Your Personal Data

You have the right to delete or request that we assist in deleting the personal data that we have collected about you.

Our service may give you the ability to delete certain information about you from within the service.

If you have an account, you can log in and go to the account settings to update, change, or delete your information. You may also contact us to request access to, correct, or delete any personal information that you have provided to us.

Please note, however, that we may need to retain certain information when we have a legal obligation or lawful basis to do so.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Business Transactions

Law enforcement

- Protect against legal liability
