Treasurer's Report

Immediate issues with new committee

- Colin will receive the fence tomorrow and we will all meet at 6.30pm for it's erection
- Alasdair printed and laminated signs to go on the fence, visible from both sides and on the bench saying PRIVATE PROPERTY, ACCESS FROM/TO THE RIVER PROHIBITED
- Full committee support is required for this should there be resistance.
- Environment Agency advice has been sought and the fence will be placed 8m from the river according to their recommendation. EA contact is Harmit Bahra - flood and costal risk management enforcement officer
- The buoy should be taken down and stored in the store cupboard
- Our unified front is essential, answering questions in a helpful way so as not to inflame any potential protestors.
- We discussed the fact that the Wadenhoe Trust and the Parish Council may question our action, but that the private land of the car park is the responsibility of the VHC alone.
- A flyer was quickly written and printed and circulated in the village and on the notice boards in the villages of benefit. CB to e-mail Wythe, Pinnington, Pollock, and Williams. Brenda and Tina delivered to Pilton Road, Dave to Main Street and the Green. Also into Achurch, Pilton, Lilford and Stoke Doyle notice boards.
