St. Thomas School Board Meeting Minutes

Prayer and Opening Remarks – Fr. Steve

Fr. Steve opened with prayer and shared several exciting updates and reflections:

- Mass Time Change: The weekday Mass schedule has been adjusted —
 Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday Masses will now begin at 7:00 AM (previously
 7:15 AM). This change allows Fr. Steve more time to greet parishioners,
 especially the children, as they arrive and depart.
- Connection with Students: Fr. Steve emphasized how important it is to be present for the children and to model the importance of Jesus in our daily lives.
- Personal Message: He expressed how proud and excited he is to be a part of the St. Thomas community.

Mission Moment – Accreditation Update (Suzi Furtwangler)

Suzi provided an overview of the upcoming accreditation cycle:

- Clarifying Accreditation: Accreditation is not a rating system. Rather, it provides a snapshot of where students are within the educational process — identifying areas of strength and opportunities for growth.
- 5-Year Cycle: Every school in the diocese undergoes accreditation every five years. This year marks St. Thomas's fifth year in the cycle.
- Evaluation Process:
 - 1. A visiting team will conduct interviews with the priest, principal, selected teachers, parents, and board members.
 - 2. After gathering data and completing interviews, the team will provide a report with findings and recommendations to the principal.
 - 3. The next cycle begins the following year.
- Standards Used: The process follows the National Standards and Benchmarks for Effective Catholic Elementary and Secondary Schools (NCEA), which focus on four key domains:
- Mission and Catholic Identity, Governance and Leadership, Academic Excellence, Operational Vitality

Principal and School Report -

Review of Summer Principal Letter – Sent June 30

The principal's summer communication highlighted key updates, transitions, and outlooks for the upcoming school year at St. Thomas:

Positive Outlook & Opportunities

- New beginnings are seen as blessings and opportunities:
 - New priest brings fresh energy and leadership to the parish.
 - New preschool marks a major step forward for the school's future.

Preschool & Enrollment

- Preschool enrollment is lower than initially projected.
 - Signage is not yet installed, which may be impacting visibility.

- Enrollment down slightly, from 333 to 323 students.
 - P3, P4, and Kindergarten are full.
 - A few families have left follow-up calls are planned to better understand their reasons for leaving.

 - Erin Breede Outreach Coordinator, focusing on raising St. Thomas's profile in the wider community
