11. Answer.

- ☐ God had already instituted marriage between Adam and Eve, when blessed them to be fruitful, and so they were already husband and wife (genesis 2:22-25, Genesis 1:27-28)
- ☐ The bible does not have a tendency of not mentioned a sin even if it is shameful. For example, the Bible speaks about Lot who lied with his daughters (Genesis 19:30-38)
- ☐ Adam and Eve ate the real fruits; the fact that Eve ate the fruits first then brought to her husband, and he ate. (Gen; 3:6). Thus, neither Eve nor Adam couldn't commit adultery by her herself or himself.
- ☐ The presence of different trees in the garden and the instructions given concerning the freedom to eat the fruits of every tree of the garden, but not from the tree of knowledge of good and evil (Genesis 2:16-17;3:6) have any application of adultery.
- ☐ The serpent provoked Eve to doubt God's order not to eat fruit from the tree of knowledge of good and evil. In fact, the serpent asked Eve whether God forbade eating fruit from any tree in the garden this doesn't indicate any sign of adultery.
