This option requires the document to be shared as “Anyone with the link can view.” Submit your report as a link in your post after a brief synopsis in the post itself. Please feel free to invite feedback from peers in that synopsis.

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BLTN fellows collaborate with their students, with each other, with members of their communities; with non-Bread Loafers; guest readers and writers; and with other Bread Loaf teachers and their students. Collaborative projects may involve cross-classroom exchanges that involve reading and responding to literature, ideas, and issues; digital production; peer-led writing and reading groups; collaborative publishing endeavors; and advocacy groups. Year-round BLTN work that arises from your vision, your experience, and the realities of your professional life are valued, appreciated, and encouraged.
