<u>Social Emotional Learning (SEL)</u>: As always, we will continue to review what it means to be a WISE Owl. For the rest of the school year, we will focus on commitment. Being committed is about taking responsibility for your actions and following through on what you say you'll do. Modeling this with students in the classroom as well as at home will help set the stage for a great foundation for learning.

<u>Math:</u> We will be working in Chapter 7, which is all about Measurement and Data, which involves using graphs, picture graphs and tally charts. At home, please have your child study their math facts for 5 minutes each day.

<u>Science</u>: Students will continue to learn about the life cycle of a plants, and how vibrating materials can make sound and that sound can make materials vibrate and how animals have similar traits to their parents.

<u>Social Studies</u>: We will be focusing on geography, how maps are used and why they are useful.

<u>Language Arts</u>: Please be sure to be reading for 15 minutes each day at home. In class this week, we will be focusing on the following skills:
