



2025 Summer Reading Program

All students at Colebrook School participate in the summer reading program. All students have been **given an orange reading log** to complete this year's summer reading program.

Students who have **been reading shorter books will be given a log to record the 50 books they read this summer**. For emerging readers, if an adult needs to do some of the reading with the child, that is absolutely fine. Please document the titles of the book on the **orange log**.

Students who have been **reading chapter books have committed to reading 3 chapter books**. Students have met with their teachers to commit to reading particular books. The intent is to ensure that students are reading books that are appropriate for their ability. You are welcome to help them select an alternate book if necessary. Students will then need to **write up a one paragraph summary** about **each book** that they have read.

Students need **to bring their orange log to school** on the **first day** of school 2025. They will be given a **prize** during the first week of school and treated to a **special surprise performance in September**.

The returned forms are also used to calculate the information for the Governor's Summer Reading Challenge. There is no need to complete a separate form.
