Abstracts are written not in the form of mathematics, questions, and conjectures. The Indonesian language abstract is a maximum of 200 words.

**Keywords:** Keywords one; Keywords two; Keywords three; etc. (English, minimum 5 keywords)

#### INTRODUCTION

Articles written using notes as citations from previous studies. The introduction contains basic information on the urgency of the issue that led to the writing of the study/research. It is written in Arial Narrow 12 font, with 1.15 spacing between paragraphs, and each paragraph begins with a word indented approximately 1 cm from the left margin of each column/paragraph. There should be no tables, images, or graphs in the introduction, and no numbers or letters should extend beyond the paragraph.

The content of the study method includes data collection techniques, data sources, data analysis methods, correlation tests, and so on, summarised in a single paragraph, written in Arial Narrow 12 font with 1.15 spacing. #### **REFERENCES**

The reference list is written in Arial Narrow 12 font and single-spaced, with a minimum of 20 book or journal references from the last 10 years. The bibliography is a list of sources/references used as citations in the manuscript. The bibliography is written according to the American Psychological Association (APA) style. Secondary sources, such as books, theses, dissertations, and internet sources, should be cited. It is recommended to use the *reference manager Mendeley*.
