

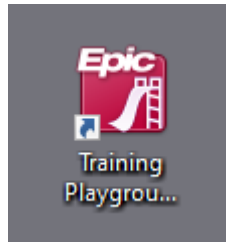
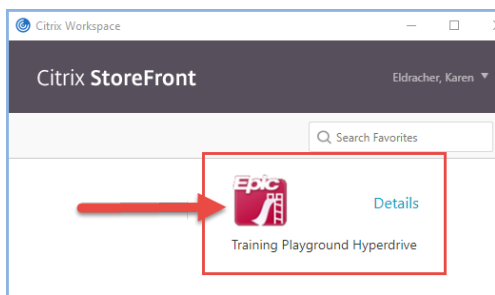
Tip Sheet – Test Your Dragon in Epic

Please follow the steps below to test out your Dragon. When you walk through the steps, you may not see your typical Epic view but the goal of this testing is to:

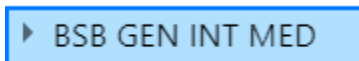
- A. Make sure you can log into your Dragon and that the Dragonbar appears.
- B. Test that your Dragon types out for you.
- C. Test any Auto Text commands that you may have.

Steps:

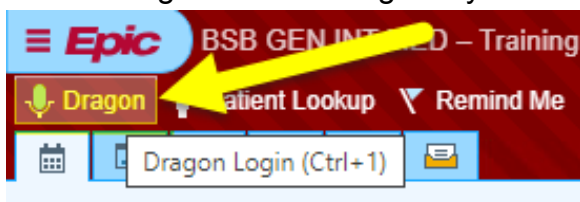
1. Make sure that you have a microphone plugged into the computer that you are testing your Dragon in Epic on.
2. Open the **Training playground** icon. The icon is either on your Citrix Workspace menu or on your desktop.




3. There are 10 different Userid logins you can try. Userid: **IM01 or IM02 or IM03 up to... IM10**
Password: **Train**
Department **BSB GEN INT MED** Click **Continue**, Click **Continue** again
4. To view some test data on the screen:
 - a. On the Calendar block, click on: **Feb 13th 2024**
 - b. Click on the option below. It is listed on the lower left side of screen. That will fill up the schedule w/encounters.



5. Click on the Dragon button to log into your Dragon (look upper left side of screen)

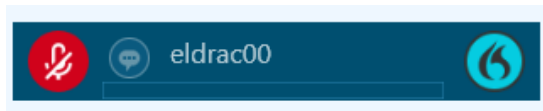


6. Once the Dragon login screen appears, change the User field value to your Userid value.



7. Your Dragonbar should appear on the screen with your Userid value listed on it.




8. On the patient schedule, double click a patient line to open up the patient's Encounter (chart).

9. To test Dragon within the encounter, click on the **Notes** tab (positioned at the right side of the screen). Turn on your Dragonbar and dictate a few sentences. If you have any Auto Text commands, test a few of the commands within the Note screen to ensure the content is there.
